College Profile:

Mahamandleshwar Shri Krishnanadji College of Commerce is a Grant-in-aid college established in June 1967, affiliated to Veer Narmad South Gujarat University, Surat, and included in the list prepared by UGC under section 2F & 12B of the UGC Act, 1956 vide letter No. UGC/42-850 dated 03-04-1969 to 2f and letter No. UGC/9556/2004 on 28/08/2004 to 12 B.

Our college is situated on the old National Highway No. 8 near Bharuch Railway Station in 33 acre campus of Sri S'ad Vidya Mandal, Bharuch, offering two basic programs, i.e., Bachelor of Commerce and Master of Commerce. The college also runs Mahamandleshwar Shri Krishnanadji College of Commerce Computer Centre, offering various undergraduate and postgraduate diploma courses.

We have sound infrastructure, including 20 lecture halls with LCD projectors and computers, Boys' and Girls' separate common rooms. We have recently installed class classroom audio broadcasting system. We have facilities like a computer, Internet, Photocopier, Intercom, inverter, Power generator, CCTV camera, water cooler, microphone, speakers, electronic bell, LCD television 32" and colour TV 29", 13kv Solar Power System, Sanitary Napkin Vending Machine-Incinerator and Fire system.

Our library consists of more than 39000 books, 100 journals/ periodicals and scores of regional and national newspapers and magazines. Our library has a rich treasure of Encyclopaedia Britannica, other encyclopaedias and some other rare collection. Our College has been part of campus of Sri S'ad

Vidya Mandal which is buzzing with academic activities. At first sight, one feels that learning and teaching environments here are congenial to students.

In June 1967, the institution started functioning from J. P. Arts and Science College, Bharuch, another prominent institution of the Mandal. At present it can boast of its own building with state of the art facilities at its disposal. Mahamandleshwar Shri Krishnanadji College of Commerce today is well-equipped with independent Shri R C Joshi Library, Computer Lab, Seminar Hall, Conference Hall, separate NCC, NSS, Gymkhana offices, Gymnasium, separate parking facilities for staff and students, sprawling lush green sports complex, Swami Atulanandji Auditorium, boys and girls hostel, and canteen facility. The institution has also banking facility in the form of Axis Bank, including an ATM, which functions from the same campus for the last seven years. Our academic endeavour also speaks volumes for itself; this institution was awarded 'The Best College of Gujarat' in the year 1986-87 and a cash prize of Rs.50, 000/- by the Government of Gujarat. This in itself is the testimony of our academic output. Some of our students have topped in the University Examinations, some have clinched medals and accolades in sports events and other competitions. This achievement is particularly remarkable on the ground that every student who desires to take admission and possesses the minimum eligibility conditions is admitted to the course. The Institution has a permanent affiliation with VNSGU Surat and has been listed under 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act, 1956.

We have drawn a perspective plan as to further our academic expansion. Pursuant to this, we have planned to propose to go for UGC UGC-sponsored and self-financing vocational course, like a vocational course in Computer. On the academic front, innovative experimenting in teaching, learning, and evaluation are being carried out by the faculties thereby making the teaching learning process more interesting, interactive and participative. It has been our attempt to nurture and foster the talent and potential of the students within the purview of the Higher Education System.

The institution has reached to its present status of eminence due to dedicated and devoted teamwork of the teaching and administrative staff and constant support, encouragement, moral and financial aids from the Management. The members of MKCC Parivar are committed to strive hard to reach still the greater heights in higher education, thus thereby fulfilling the aspirations and expectations of the society and founding Saints of the institution who have contributed tremendously to the cause of higher education.

➤ Vande Mataram @ 150:

The NSS Camp was a meaningful and enriching experience, reflecting the true spirit of “Not Me, But You” and strengthening the bond between the college and the community.



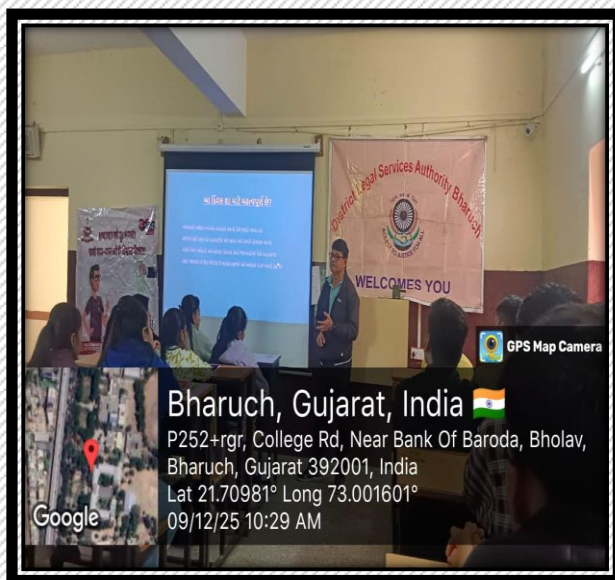
➤ Anti-Corruption Day:
